COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENTS:

The Tot Lot resurfacing is complete and our playground areas will be ready to open as soon as permitted per the Riverside County and the City of Temecula guidelines. For the health and safety of our residents, please be respectful and follow all CDC and local government guidelines when using the common areas. To protect our residents, if someone is not feeling well, please refrain from utilizing these areas. We are proud of our community and appreciate your response towards dealing with this situation. Landscaping improvements have been completed around the mailbox areas on Embassy. In the past, these areas were difficult to keep well maintained.
